As part of the mentor application, you are required to get a **criminal record check** completed.

You will need to go in person to your local RCMP or police station and fill in the Criminal Record check form (**including the vulnerable sector section**) in order to allow you to work with children.

Make sure to have the record check mailed directly to NIMA. Our address is at the top of this form. Be sure to bring two pieces of I.D. Please submit this form as soon as possible. It must be returned before you are able to volunteer.
