November 4th, 2020 - Election notice posted for NIMA Board

November 4th - December 4th, 2020 - NIMA Citizens may submit nominations for all NIMA Board positions as listed on the nomination form.

December 4th, 2020 - Nomination submission ends

December 9th, 2020 - NIMA will announce acclaimed positions, vacant positions and official candidates list on this website. Ballots will be mailed out to all NIMA Citizens in good standing.

January 22th, 2021 - Election ballots must be submitted by this date to be included in the election results.

January 25th, 2021 - Election results will be posted on the NIMA website

February 7th, 2021 - NIMA 2021 AGM will be hosted through Zoom. Registration is required. Details will be posted soon.
